H.S.A. FUNDRAISING MEETING

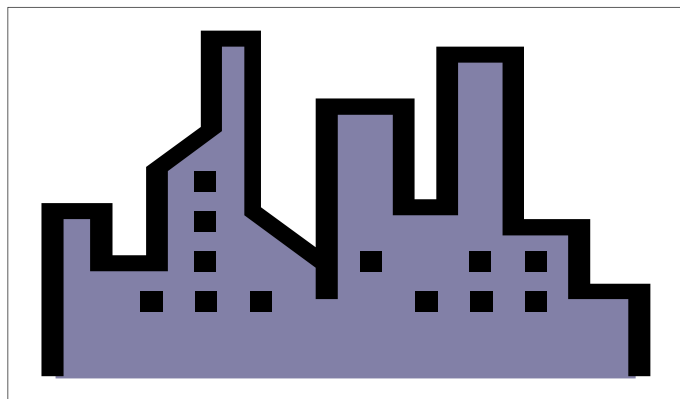
